Be an Anaphylaxis Community Expert

Anaphylaxis is an immediate, generalized, severe allergic reaction. It is similar to heart attacks in that prevention, early recognition and prompt treatment all save lives.

The Heart Association reduced the risk of death from heart attacks by offering a standard program of CPR training to the public. The Allergy & Asthma Network wants to do the same thing for anaphylaxis by training patients and caretakers of at-risk patients to become *Anaphylaxis Community Experts* (ACE).

If you are at risk due to food or other allergies, insect stings, or anaphylaxis with no known cause, or if you care for anyone at risk, ACE training may help you save a life.

The Network asked one of the national allergy scientific societies to choose 150 allergists from all parts of the US to launch the first version of the ACE training program in their communities. We were chosen to bring it to our area.
